St Peters Lutheran College Future Foundation offers the Rural Leadership Scholarship and provides opportunities for a Boarding student to benefit from a St Peters education, who may not have been able to do so without financial assistance.

This application for scholarship forms the first step in the application process. The application closing date is **Tuesday 15 August 2017**. Shortlisted applicants will be interviewed during the week commencing 4 September 2017 at St Peters Lutheran College, Indooroopilly.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Rural Leadership Scholarship you need to be/have:

- A Year 10 student in 2018;
- Australian citizen or permanent resident;
- 200 km or more away from St Peters Lutheran College, Indooroopilly;
- Exceptional leadership and academic, music, drama, visual art or sporting excellence;
- Willing to participate in a wide range of activities outside of the academic program, including leadership and service to others;
- Parents who are unable to consider St Peters for financial reasons; and
- Parents who are committed to cover any expenses over and above the scholarship amount of \$35,000 per annum.

The Rural Leadership Scholarship is means-tested. Parents of shortlisted students will be required to provide last year's tax return.
